1 Scope / Controller / Data Protection Officer / Representative

This Privacy Policy describes our collection, use, disclosure, retention and protection of your personal data and your rights in relation to the processing of your personal data. It applies to any ERNI website where this Privacy Policy appears in the footer, and to any ERNI system, application, service, or tool (collectively "Services") where this Privacy Policy is referenced, regardless of how you access or use them, including through mobile devices.

This Privacy Policy is based on the requirements of the EU General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") and the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection ("FADP").

Please note that this Privacy Policy is not necessarily a comprehensive description of our data processing. It is possible that other privacy policies or general terms and conditions or similar documents are applicable to specific circumstances.

The company of the ERNI Group you are contracting with is your data controller, and is responsible for the collection, use, disclosure, retention and protection of your personal data in accordance with this Privacy Policy and our global privacy standards (see Section 2) as well as any applicable national laws. When you are using our website, ERNI Management Services AG is your data controller, and is responsible for the collection, use, disclosure, retention and protection of your personal data in accordance with this Privacy Policy and our Cookie Policy.

We may process and retain your personal data on our servers in Europe and elsewhere in the world where our data centres or cloud service provider are located. In any case we implement appropriate measures (technical and/or contractual) to ensure the data privacy level according to GDPR at all our data centres or with all our cloud service provider.

1.1 Personal Data

"Personal Data" is information that can be associated with a specific person and could be used to identify that specific person whether from that data or from that data and other information that we have or are likely to have access to. We do not consider personal data to include information that has been made anonymous within the meaning of the GDPR and FADP or aggregated so that it can no longer be used to identify a specific person, whether in combination with other information or otherwise.

4.2.1 Targeted E-mail

We use the Marketing Automation Software Solution ClickDimension to send commercial e-mail to individuals at our client or other companies with whom we want to develop or maintain a business relationship in accordance with applicable marketing laws. Our targeted e-mail messages typically include web beacons, cookies, and similar technologies that allow us to know whether you open, read, or delete the message, and links you may click. When you click a link in a marketing e-mail you receive from us, we will also use a cookie to log what pages you view and what content you download from our websites, even if you are not registered at or signed into our site.

All our commercial e-mails include a link where you can opt out from our mailing lists. Targeted e-mails from us may include additional data privacy information, as required by applicable laws.

4.2.2 Customer Relationship Management (CRM) Databases

Like all companies, we use customer relationship management (CRM) database technology provided by Microsoft Dynamics 365 to manage and track our marketing efforts. Our CRM databases include personal data belonging to individuals at our client and other companies with whom we already have

a business relationship or want to develop one. The personal data used for these purposes includes relevant business information.

If you wish to be excluded from our CRM databases, please inform us via the Contact Us form or by sending us an email to dataprotection@betterask.erni.

4.2.3 Combining and Analyzing personal data

As described above, we may combine data from publicly available sources, and from our different e-mail, website, and personal interactions with you (this includes information collected across our different websites such as our careers and corporate sites and information collected when you sign-up or log on to our websites or connect to our websites using your social media credentials (such as LinkedIn and Xing). We combine this data to better assess your experience with ERNI and to perform the other activities described throughout our Privacy Policy.

4.2.4 Your rights (right to object)

You can exercise your right to prevent marketing communications to you by checking certain boxes on the forms we use to collect your personal data, or by utilizing opt-out mechanisms in e-mails we send to you. You can also exercise the right to discontinue marketing communications to you, or to have your personal data removed from our customer relationship management (CRM) databases at any time by using our Contact Us form or our Privacy Center on the webpage. In such cases, we will retain minimum personal data to note that you opted out in order to avoid contacting you again.

- In case of an employment, the personal data may be forwarded to external partners for work contract preparation and work permit organization (Article 6 para. 1 lit. b GDPR).

4.7 Prevent, detect, mitigate and investigate fraudulent or illegal activities (Article 6 para. 1 lit. c/f GDPR)

- Prevent, detect, mitigate and investigate fraud, security breaches, potentially prohibited or illegal activities
- Enforce our Privacy Policy, our User Agreement or other policies

4.8 Data Retention

We retain your personal data as long as it is necessary and relevant for our operations. In addition, we may retain personal data from closed accounts to comply with national laws, prevent fraud, collect any fees owed, resolve disputes, troubleshoot problems, assist with any investigation, and take other actions permitted or required by applicable national laws. After it is no longer necessary for us to retain your personal data, we dispose of it in a secure manner according to our data retention and deletion policies.

4.8.1 Retention Candidate Data

The personal data of the candidate will be saved up to two years. Afterwards, the personal data of the candidate will get deleted automatically. However, saving the personal data of the candidate for a longer time range than two years can be agreed between the candidate and ERNI in a written form (where applicable; depending on legal situation of the corresponding country).

The candidate will always be able to request a deletion of her/his personal data via e-mail or via post (see imprint of join.ERNI for further information).

5 Choice

You have a choice about how we use your personal data to communicate with you and to send you marketing information.

5.1 Marketing and communication preferences

If you do not wish to receive marketing communications from us, you can unsubscribe from the link in the e-mail you received, change your Communication Preferences or indicate your communication preferences within the direct communication from us.

5.2 Withdraw consent

If you wish to withdraw your consent, please send us an e-mail to marketing@erni.ch. Please consider, that if you withdraw your consent for the use or disclosure of your personal data for purposes set out in this Privacy Policy, you may not have access to all our Services and we might not be able to provide you some or all of the Services and customer support offered to our users and authorized under this Privacy Policy.

6 Your rights

It is important to us that our data processing is fair and transparent. It is therefore important to us that you can exercise the following rights in addition to your right to object if the respective legal requirements are met:

- Right of access, Art. 15 GDPR

- Right of rectification, Art. 16 GDPR
- Right of erasure ("right to be forgotten"), Art. 17 GDPR
- Right of restriction of processing, Art. 18 GDPR
- Right to data portability, Art. 20 GDPR
- • Right to object, Art. 21 GDPR

Furthermore, according to Article 77 GDPR you have the right to appeal to a supervisory authority. The competent data protection authority in Switzerland is the Federal Data Protection and Information Commissioner "EDÖB" (<https://www.edoeb.admin.ch/edoeb/de/home.html>).

7 Disclosure

We may transfer your personal data to other companies of the ERNI Group or to third parties as described below. This transfer may be required for to operate (for example Cloud Services) and to provide you access to our Services, to perform Customer satisfaction surveys, to comply with our legal obligations, to facilitate our marketing and advertising activities, or to prevent, detect, mitigate and investigate fraudulent or illegal activities related to our Services. We minimize the amount of personal data we transfer to what is directly relevant and necessary to accomplish the specified purpose. As stated above, we do not transfer your personal data to third parties (other than ERNI Group companies) for their marketing and advertising purposes.

We may transfer your personal data to the following parties and for the following purposes:

7.1 ERNI Group companies, who may use it to:

- provide joint content and services (such as customer support)
- help detect and prevent potentially fraudulent and illegal acts, violations of our User Agreement and data security breaches
- guide decisions about their products, sites, applications, services, tools and marketing communications. Companies of ERNI Group will use your personal data to send you marketing communications only if you have consented to receive such communications from them

7.2 ERNI Customers

- submitting CV of our employees towards Customers to verify the expertise level

7.3 Service Providers and financial institution partners

- Third party service providers who help us to provide our Services, payment processing services, assist us in providing customized advertising, to assist us with the prevention, detection, mitigation and investigation of potentially illegal acts, violations of our User Agreement, fraud and/or security breaches, bill collection, and other business operations
- Third party service providers who provide us Cloud Services and Cloud Storage

7.4 Law enforcement, legal proceedings and as authorized by law

- to comply with our legal requirements, respond to claims that a listing or other content violates the rights of others, or protect anyone's rights, property or safety.
- to law enforcement or governmental agencies, or authorized third-parties, in response to a verified request relating to a criminal investigation or alleged or suspected illegal activity or any other activity that may expose us, you, or any other of our users to legal liability. We will only transfer information we deem relevant to the investigation or inquiry, such as name,

- city, state, postcode, telephone number, email address, User ID history, IP address, fraud complaints
- to third parties involved in a legal proceeding, if they provide us with a subpoena, court order or substantially similar legal procedure, or we otherwise believe in good faith that the disclosure of information is necessary to prevent imminent physical harm or financial loss or to report suspected illegal activity

8 Data Transfers Abroad

We may transfer your personal data to recipients abroad (they may be located in any country worldwide), including to countries that do not provide the same level of protection as Switzerland or the member states of the EU/EEA. If we transfer your personal data to such a country, we take appropriate measures to protect your personal data, such as concluding data transfer agreements based on „Standard Contractual Clauses“ (SCC). Please contact us if you would like to receive a copy of our data transfer agreements. In exceptional cases, your personal data may be transferred to countries without adequate protection, e.g. if explicit consent has been granted (Article 49 para. 1 lit. a GDPR), to execute a contract with the person concerned, or to process your contract request (lit. b), to conclude or execute a contract with someone else in the interest of the person concerned (lit. c), or to establish, exercise or defend legal rights (lit. e).

9 Security

We manage Information Security with our ISO 27001:2013 certified Information Security Management System (ISMS). Within ISMS we protect your personal data using technical and organizational security measures to reduce the risks of loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure and alteration. Some of the safeguards we use are firewalls and data encryption, physical access controls to our data centres and information access authorization controls. If you believe your personal data had been misused, please contact us following the instructions in the Contact Us section (Art. 10) below.

10 Third Party Privacy Practices

This Privacy Policy addresses only the use and disclosure of personal data we collect from you. If you disclose your information to others, or if you are directed to a third-party website, their privacy policies and practices will apply.

We cannot guarantee the privacy or security of your personal data once you provide it to a third party and we encourage you to evaluate the privacy and security policies before you share your information.

11 Cookie Policy

11.1 Cookie Notice

When you visit our website, the site asks your browser to store a small piece of data (text file) called a cookie on your device in order to remember information about you, such as your language preference or login information. Those cookies are set by us and called first-party cookies. We also use third-party cookies, which are cookies from a domain different than the domain of the website you are visiting, for our advertising and marketing efforts.

A cookie is a small text file that a website, app or other platform stores on your computer, tablet, smartphone or any other similar device, with information on your browsing and use, like a tag that identifies your device. Cookies are necessary, for example, to facilitate browsing and understand how users interact with platforms so they can be improved. They are also useful to provide advertising

according to user preferences, as well as for other purposes detailed below. Cookies do not damage your computer or device.

By “Cookies” we are also referring to other, similar technologies used to install and/or collect information on or from your device such as flash cookies, web beacons or bugs, pixels, HTML5 (local storage), and SDK technologies for apps. These technologies sometimes run alongside cookies to collect and store information, either to provide you with certain features or services on our website, or to display third-party advertising according to your browsing.

You will be able to find in this Cookie Policy information related to the types of cookies that we use, the purpose for their use and the different options for managing or deleting them. 11.2 Cookie types

Necessary cookies

These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but that will cause some parts of the site to not work. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

Analytics cookies

These cookies can quantify the number of users, sections visited on the platform and how users interact with it to carry out statistical measurement and analysis on use, in order to implement improvements based on the analysis of data on how users use the platform or service.

Advertisement cookies

Advertisement cookies are those which store information on user behaviour obtained from continuous observation of their browsing habits, which allows us to develop a specific profile for displaying advertising adapted to these habits. These cookies allow for the most effective management possible of any advertising space the editor has included directly or in collaboration with third parties.

11.3 What are cookies used for in our website?

Cookies are an essential part of our website. The main goal of our cookies is to make your browsing experience as easy and efficient as possible. For example, they are used to remember your preferences (language, country, etc.) when browsing and during future visits. We also use our cookies to continuously improve our services and website, and to offer customised advertising according to your browsing habits.

Information collected on cookies also allows us to improve our website by making estimates on statistical data and patterns of use (number of visits, most visited sections, visit time, etc.), gain a statistical understanding of how users interact with the website so as to improve our services, and to adapt the website to your individual interests, accelerate searches, etc.

We may sometimes use cookies to obtain information that enables us to display advertising, from our website, third-party platforms or any other means, based on an analysis of your browsing habits (products visited, sections consulted, etc.).

In any case, the cookies we use never store sensitive information such as passwords, credit or debit card details, etc.

11.4 When do I give my consent to use cookies?

When you reach our website and before starting the navigation, you will be warned about the use of cookies, so that you can give your consent in relation to our Cookies Policy.

11.5 How to control and delete Cookies

At any time, you will be able to disable cookies and continue navigating, although navigation will be limited and could be blocked at some point. You may be able to block or disable them in the browser settings, which permits to reject the installation of all the cookies or part of them. Most browsers allow the possibility of informing of the existence of cookies or reject them automatically. If you reject cookies, you will be able to continue using our website, although some functionality will be limited negatively impacting on your experience in our website.
